Incident Safety Officer

An incident safety officer is an individual who has met the requirements of Fire Officer Level I specified in NFPA 1021, Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications and Chapter 6 of NFPA 1521, Standard for Fire Department Safety Officer and has the knowledge, skill, and abilities to manage incident scene safety by having and maintaining a knowledge of:

- Emergency operations
- Building construction
- Fire science and behavior relative to predicting hostile fire events
- The fire department's personnel accountability system
- Incident scene rehabilitation strategies. Additional Incident Safety Officer duties include:
 - Risk evaluation
 - Resource evaluation
 - Hazard identification and communication
 - Action plan review
 - Safety briefings
 - Collapse zoning
 - Accident investigation
 - Post-incident analysis
 - Safety committee participation

The Incident Safety Officer Course is a 24-hour course that covers everything from the responsibilities of being an ISO to conducting evaluations and analysis of incident scenes. As a Incident Safety Officer you have a lot of responsibilities in the field along with around the fire station as well.
